

GROUP GUIDELINES FOR NBGC DAY CAMP CARNIVAL

Prior to Arrival

- Please contact Mary Jeske at our Group Reservation Hotline at (773) 463-4161 x10, if you have any questions or changes in group size from your original estimate.
- Pricing is based on availability and is subject to change. Please make your reservation early to receive the best price.
- A final count for your group is due by July 12, 2010. If you bring more people than your Purchase Order will cover, additional campers and adults must be paid for with cash, check or credit card (Visa/Mastercard).
- Groups with children under 6 years old are required to have a 1:5 counselor to camper ratio. With children 6 years and over the ratio is 1:10. Counselors must remain with their children at all times.

Directions to Festival Grounds at 3900 N. Rockwell, Chicago, 60618

- If coming from the south, exit the Kennedy (90) at exit 47 A to Western Ave. and travel north to Irving Park Road. Turn west (left) on Irving Park two blocks to Rockwell and turn left at the light. If you pass the Chicago River you missed us!
- If coming from the north, exit the Kennedy (90) at Irving Park Rd. and travel east to Rockwell Ave. (first street after passing over the Chicago River). Make an immediate right turn on Rockwell. If you reach Western Ave. you have missed us by two blocks.
- Follow the driveway to the south end of the parking lot where you will be directed to the drop off point

Upon Arrival (Refer to General Rules & Map)

- For Wednesday, July 28th and Thursday, July 29th – Please plan your arrival between 11:30 am and 11:45 am. Rides will not open before Noon.
- For Friday, July 30th – Please plan your arrival between 10:30 am and 10:45 am. Rides will not open before 11:00 am.
- Please arrive on time. Unfortunately, if you are late, we will not be able to extend your time at the Carnival.
- Please have your Bus Driver follow our **General Rules & Map** when dropping off and picking up your group.
- Have your Group Leader check your Group In. Wristbands and Receipts will be given to the Group Leader.
- Final payments (cash, check, Visa/Mastercard or purchase order) must be made before wristbands are distributed.
- After your group has unloaded, your bus driver will be directed to a parking area.
- Wristbands must not be taken off for the duration of the day. Remove your wristband and lose ride privileges.
- Wristbands are only good for the dates and times of your reservation. They cannot be used again on another day or time.

Upon Entering The Ride Area

- Please point out the washrooms to your group members, located west of the ride area.
- Please ask your group members to use garbage cans for wrappers, cans, etc.
- A seating area is available west of the food tent for your convenience. Please clear your tables after eating. ***The seating area is open until 2:00.***
- Groups are welcome to picnic in the park. A gate in the south parking lot fence will be unlocked for park access. Please bring a trash bag with you, so that your group can properly dispose of trash.
- While the rides are included in your price, several action games will be operating. Campers should bring extra money if they would like to participate in these games.
- For everyone's safety, please ask group members to avoid running through the ride area. Rollerblading and skateboarding are prohibited.
- If anyone is in need of First Aid, please bring them to the Check In Area.
- Lost & Found will be located at the Check In Area.
- There will be a minimum of 16 rides and at least four of those will be "kiddie rides". Some of the larger rides have minimum height restrictions.

Day Camp Specials

- **A hot dog, chips and drink lunch will be available for just \$2.50 at the NBGC Food Tent west of the ride area**
- Other refreshments that will be available include pizza, nachos, water, ice cream and freeze pops
