## SEASON INFORMATION

- Games will run for 90 minutes or 7 innings. Whichever comes first.
- Any changes due to weather will be communicated by NBGC athletic staff via email.
- Each team will play 1-2 games per week.
- If you are interested in volunteering as a coach, please indicate so on your registration form. Coaches will be asked to fill out a volunteer application and will be subject to a background check if they have not already done so in the past 12 months.
- Players should bring a glove, bat, cleats, and batting helmet.

- Spectators should remain in the designated spectator areas.
- All equipment, high touch surfaces, and facilities will be cleaned according to IDPH guidelines.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

**Where will practices and games take place?** Practices and games will take place at Revere Park, located at 2501 W. Irving Park Rd.

**What happens if weather prevents a game from occurring?** Any changes due to serious weather concerns will be communicated by the NBGC staff in advance.

**Can I stick around and watch my child?** NBGC's spectator policy will adhere to the IDPH sports guidelines. Spectators must remain in the designated spectator area.

**How are teams put together?** Teams are constructed by looking at school, grade, neighborhood, and requests. All requests MUST be included in the registration form. Requests sent in by email will not be considered.

**What should my child bring to practices and games?** Players should come with a labeled water bottle, cleats, bat, glove, and batting helmet. Other gear such as a protective cup is optional but recommended.

**What can I expect from an NBGC practice or game?** Preseason practices will begin with dynamic stretching followed by working on fundamental skills like hitting, fielding, throwing, and basic game knowledge.

**Are there any NBGC practices during the season?** No, once the games start any additional practices throughout the season will be coach-run practices.

**How will program changes be communicated?** Program is subject to change due to COVID-19 Phase and Tier mitigations. Any changes in programming will be communicated to the email addresses listed on the registration form.

**What happens if I am late/early to drop-off/pick-up?** If you are early to drop-off, please wait until you are called to the proper field. If you are late to pick-up, your child will be brought inside the clubhouse to wait. Please note this may incur charges.

**Will players be transported to program?** Players in NBGC's summer camp will be brought to their game by NBGC staff.

**What governmental guidelines will NBGC be following?** The NBGC will be following guidelines and recommendations of the IDPH, Chicago Park District, CDC, City of Chicago, Chicago Park District, and State of Illinois Restore Plan.

**What are your COVID-19 quarantine and isolation procedures?**

<b>CLOSE CONTACT</b>	
Vaccinated	Unvaccinated
May continue in programming as long as no COVID-19 symptoms appear.	Cannot participate in programming for 5 days and should be tested on day 6.

<b>POSITIVE TEST</b>	
Symptomatic	Asymptomatic
May return to programming on day 6. Day 0 is the date of the test or symptoms, whichever comes after.	Cannot participate in programming until day 6 <b>AND</b> being fever free for 24 hours.

**When will face masks be required?** Face masks are optional, but encouraged.

**What is the cancellation policy?** If you wish to cancel your program registration less than 7 days before the start of the program, a 25% cancellation fee will be charged; if more than 7 days before the start date of the program, a full refund or program credit will be applied. No partial refunds will be paid if participants miss any practices. Due to the ongoing pandemic, NBGC reserves the right to modify or cancel programs at any time for purposes of public safety or compliance. Should this occur we will notify all participants and work with you on next steps, including any applicable refunds.
