- Each team will play 1-2 games per week. 1 weekday game and/or 1 weekend game on Saturday.
- Makeup games will be scheduled as needed on Friday, your league's usual game day, its alternate day, or Saturday. Forfeits will not be rescheduled.
- Any changes due to weather will be communicated by NBGC athletic staff.
- If you are interested in volunteering as a coach, please indicate so on your registration form. Coaches will be asked to fill out a volunteer application and will be subject to a background check if they have not already done so in the past 12 months.
- Players should come equipped with a labeled water bottle, their team uniform, and sneakers or cleats. Other gear like a mouth guards or protective cups are optional. **Shin guards are required and must be covered with long socks.**

COVID-19 PROCEDURES AND PRECAUTIONS

- Only registered participants allowed on direct field space.
- Spectators should remain in the designated spectator areas.
- All equipment, high touch surfaces, and facilities will be cleaned according to IDPH guidelines.

Frequently Asked Questions

Where will practices and games take place? Practices and games will take place at Revere Park, located at 2501 W. Irving Park Rd.

What happens if weather prevents a game from occurring? We play through most weather conditions, but any changes due to serious weather concerns will be communicated by the NBGC staff in advance.

Can I stick around and watch my child? NBGC's spectator policy will adhere to the IDPH sports guidelines. Spectators must remain in the designated spectator area.

How are teams put together? Teams are constructed by looking at school, grade, neighborhood, and requests. All requests **MUST** be included in the registration form. Requests sent in by email will not be considered.

What should my child bring to practices and games? Players should come with a labeled water bottle, shin guards, and cleats or sneakers. Other gear such as a mouthguard is optional. **Shin guards are required and must be covered with long socks.**

What can I expect from an NBGC preseason practice? Preseason practices will begin with dynamic stretching followed by working on fundamental skills like passing, shooting, dribbling, defense, and basic game knowledge.

Are there any NBGC-scheduled practices during the season? No, NBGC only schedules preseason practices. Once the games start any additional practices throughout the season will be coach-scheduled practices.

How do I register for a program? Registration form and informational flyer can be located on the NBGC website at nbgc.org/athletic-programs. Financial assistance is available upon request, please contact finance@nbgc.org.

How will program changes be communicated? Program is subject to change due to COVID-19 Phase and Tier mitigations. Any changes in programming will be communicated to the email addresses listed on the registration form.

What happens if I am late/early to drop-off/pick-up? If you are early to drop-off, please wait until you are called to the proper field. If you are late to pick-up, your child will be brought inside the clubhouse to wait. Please note this may incur charges.

Will players be transported to program? Players in NBGC's after-school program will be brought to their game by NBGC staff if **all** of the following situations apply:

- 1) The player is enrolled at NBGC's after-school program at Bateman Elementary, Cleveland Elementary, or Coonley Elementary and is present in the program that day.
- 2) The player has an NBGC-scheduled preseason practice or game with a start time **before** 5:30 PM. (Please note that transportation will not be provided to coach-scheduled team practices).

What governmental guidelines will NBGC be following? The NBGC will be following guidelines and recommendations of the IDPH, Chicago Park District, CDC, City of Chicago, Chicago Park District, and State of Illinois Restore Plan.

What are your COVID-19 quarantine and isolation procedures?

CLOSE CONTACT	
<u>Vaccinated</u>	<u>Unvaccinated</u>
May continue in programming as long as no COVID-19 symptoms appear.	Cannot participate in programming for 5 days and should be tested on day 6.

POSITIVE TEST	
<u>Symptomatic</u>	<u>Asymptomatic</u>
May return to programming on day 6. Day 0 is the date the positive test is taken or the day symptoms appear, whichever comes second. Must also be fever-free for 24 hours. A mask must be worn until day 11.	Cannot participate in programming until day 6. Day 0 is the date the positive test is taken. A mask must be worn until day 11.

When will face masks be required? Face masks are optional, but encouraged.

What is the cancellation policy? If you wish to cancel your program registration less than 7 days before the start of the program, a 25% cancellation fee will be charged; if more than 7 days before the start date of the program, a full refund or program credit will be applied. No partial refunds will be paid if participants miss any practices. Due to the ongoing pandemic, NBGC reserves the right to modify or cancel programs at any time for purposes of public safety or compliance. Should this occur we will notify all participants and work with you on next steps, including any applicable refunds.
