Athletic Guidelines Due to COVID-19

Winter II Program 2021

At the Neighborhood Boys and Girls Club the safety and well-being of our members, community, leaders and staff is our top priority. As we continue to navigate through these unprecedented times, we at NBGC are taking all necessary precautions to ensure that we will provide a fun and safe environment for our families. In order to properly and effectively run programs the Neighborhood Boys and Girls Club will be following CDC, IDPH, IDHR, IDHS, ACA, City of Chicago and state of Illinois's Restore plan recommendations. In addition to these recommendations the Neighborhood Boys and Girls Club will be implementing the following best practices:

Face coverings

Initials _____

All members will be required to wear a face mask or cloth covering at all times (NO gaiters or bandanas). We ask that you make sure you send your child with a mask they can wear for an extended period of time and that it fits well. It should keep their nose covered without constant readjusting. If refusal to wear a mask properly becomes a constant issue, we will ask for your child to stay home until they can comply with proper masking wearing rules.

Wellness Screenings

Initials _____

All participants must be accompanied by an adult at drop-off, adult must remain with youth until wellness screen is complete. Wellness screen will consist of a temperature check and routine wellness questions. Wellness questions will be made available via a google form and must be completed for each participant prior to each practice. If a child exhibits a temperature at or above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, they will not be allowed to enter the Clubhouse and participate in programming for the day. Once wellness screen is complete only registered participants will be allowed into the Clubhouse.

Safety procedures

Initials _____

If a participant has symptoms related to COVID-19, they should wait to enter premises until they have had no fever for at least 72 hours, other symptoms have improved, and at least 10 days have passed since their symptoms first appeared. If participant does contract COVID-19, they should notify athletics@nbgc.org and remain isolated at home for a minimum of 10 days after symptom onset and can be released after feverless and feeling well (without fever-reducing medication) for at least 72 hours OR has 2 negative COVID-19 tests in a row, with testing done at least 24 hours apart.

Hand washing

Initials _____

All youth and staff will be required to sanitize their hands thoroughly upon entering and leaving the batting cage, hand sanitizer will be provided. Soap and water will also be accessible at the facility.

Water bottles

Initials _____

Due to the State of Illinois building guidelines, the NBGC building does not have functioning water fountains. Thus, participants must bring their own water bottle, clearly labeled with their first and last name.

Spectator policy

Initials _____

Due to the nature and restrictions necessary to run programming we will not be allowing parents to enter the Clubhouse. In accordance with Phase 4 of Restore Illinois Plan and social distancing guidelines only youth registered will be allowed to enter the Clubhouse during their designated practice day and time. No spectators (parents, friends, siblings, etc.) will be allowed into the Clubhouse.

Travel policy

Initials _____

If the participant travels, we ask that you comply with Chicago's Emergency Travel Order, which may require a 14-day quarantine before returning to program. We also ask that notify athletics@nbgc.org of any travel outside the city, state or US.
