

Even though football and basketball are just getting started *it won't be long before we're ready for winter sports!* Boys Basketball and Girls Indoor Soccer and Volleyball sign up open on Sat. Oct. 10th for returning players, and Mon. Oct. 12th for new players.

Basketball is open to 2nd - 10th grade boys born from Sept. 1, 1982 through Aug. 31, 1991, and to 2nd - 8th grade girls born from Sept. 1, 1984 through Aug. 31, 1991. There will be four boys leagues and three girls leagues. Basketball practices start the first week of November and teams are limited to the first 10 (8 for Cadet) who sign up. Volleyball and Soccer practices start in early December. There is no fee to join, but players will need a team shirt.

Cadet and Prep boys, Pebble and Junior girls and all new members must have their mom or dad present for registration. Tribes and Seniors who did not play football or basketball must also bring their mom or dad. New members are required to show their birth certificate. If you sign up during the dates below and before your neighborhood team fills up, you are guaranteed a roster spot. If your team is filled or you come in late, you go onto the waiting list and will be placed on a team just before the start of the season.
