The Neighborhood Boys & Girls Club (NBGC), founded in 1931, is a non-profit organization committed to youth development. Our mission is to enhance the well-being and potential of our members, their families, and the community.

For over 90 years, NBGC has continuously pursued excellence in its youth services and organizational governance, driven by the vision of "building better men and women." We are proud of our uninterrupted service to the community, and our board, staff, leaders, and volunteers are unwavering in their dedication to meeting and exceeding the needs of youth and families.

Founded by Robert Buehler and Richard Valentin, NBGC's roots trace back to a single football game played at Revere Park in 1931. What began in a small Chicago garage has grown into a thriving organization that embodies the vision of its visionary founders.

- Clinics will take place at the Revere Park tennis courts.
- Players should come prepared with a racket, water bottle, and athletic attire.
- Participants will be split into a K-3rd grade group and a 4th-8th grade group.
- Any cancellations due to inclement weather will be communicated at the earliest possible opportunity via email.
- Clinics are taught by our USTA-trained staff using the USTA Tennis 101 curriculum.

- Classes will be taught by Sensei Bob Muralles, 5th Dan Black Belt, Midwest Circuit Champion, M.A.K.A. Champion, Power Nationals Champion, London, Can-Am Police & Fire Games champion.
- Kata will be the focus of the Karate Program. Kata helps refine techniques and improve body mechanics associated with the execution of techniques.
- All class curriculum will be from instructor's Hombu Dojo "Jun Ko Kan", Phoenix, Arizona.
- All returning participants must re-register for Fall & Spring sessions.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- How do I register for a program?
 - You can register for a program by locating the registration form and informational flyer on the NBGC website at nbgc.org/athletic-programs.
- How are teams put together?
 - Teams are constructed by considering school, grade, neighborhood, and requests. All requests MUST be included in the registration form. Requests sent via email will not be considered.
- Is financial assistance available?
 - Yes, financial assistance is available upon request. If you have previously applied for financial assistance, please take note that a new application must be submitted at the beginning of each program year (each fall). To apply, email <u>finance@nbgc.org</u> or visit <u>nbgc.org/athletic-programs</u>.
- How do I apply my NBGC Program Credit?
 - To redeem your program credit(s), please contact finance@nbgc.org.
- Where will practices and games take place?
 - All NBGC-scheduled games and practices will take place at Revere Park, located at 2501 W. Irving Park Rd.
- What should my child bring to practices and games?
 - Players should come to practices with a labeled water bottle and cleats or sneakers. Other gear such as a mouthguard or athletic cup is optional. For games, players should come with the items listed above and their game jerseys.
- What can I expect from an NBGC Preseason Practice or game?
 - Preseason Practices are scheduled to last for 45-50 minutes and will begin with dynamic stretching followed by working on fundamental game skills, strategies, and rules. Games are scheduled to last for 50-60 minutes.
 - Preseason practices include all the players in the league, regardless of team, and are fully run by NBGC staff. Team coaches don't need to worry about bringing practice plans, materials, or equipment.
 - Each league is scheduled for 2-3 preseason practices before the games begin.
- Are there any NBGC-scheduled team practices during the season?
 - No, NBGC only schedules league preseason practices. Once the games start, any additional practices throughout the season will be coach-scheduled team practices.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- How many games will my player have?
 - In a general season, teams are scheduled for 1 preseason game, 6-8 regular season games, 1-2 playoff games, and an all-star game and/or parents vs. kids game. Numbers may vary slightly depending on season length or gym time available.
- Will forfeits be rescheduled?
 - No, forfeits will not be rescheduled. Please let NBGC staff know about upcoming forfeits so we can try to find a replacement team for your opponent.
- What happens if I am late/early to drop-off/pick-up?
 - If you are early to drop-off, please wait until you are called to the proper field.
 If you are late to pick-up, your child will be brought inside the clubhouse to wait. Please note this may incur childcare charges unless prior arrangements have been made.
- Will players be transported to program? Players in NBGC's after-school program will be brought to their game by NBGC staff if all of the following situations apply:
 - 1) The player is enrolled at NBGC's after school programs at NBGC, Bateman Elementary, Cleveland Elementary, or Linne Elementary and is present in the program that day.
 - 2) The player has an NBGC-scheduled Preseason Practice or game with a start time at or before 5:30 PM.
- What is the cancellation policy?
 - If you cancel prior to the start of programming, a Program Credit will be posted to your account. All registration fees are non-refundable. Cancellation requests must be emailed to <u>athletics@nbgc.org</u> and <u>finance@nbgc.org</u>.
- Can I coach?
 - If you are interested in volunteering as a coach, please indicate so on your registration form. Coaches will be asked to fill out a volunteer application and will be subject to a background check if they have not already done so in the past 12 months.
- Season Information:
 - The season will start with 2 preseason practices spread out over 1-2 weeks
 - Each team will play 1-2 games per week 1 weekday game and/or 1 weekend game on Saturday. Occasional bye-weeks possible depending on league structure.
 - Makeup games will be scheduled as needed on Friday, your league's usual game day/alternate day, or Saturday. Forfeits will not be rescheduled.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- When will my player receive their uniform
 - Players typically receive their team uniform at their first game. This may vary slightly depending on supply chain factors.
- When will I see my child's schedules
 - Preseason Practice schedules can be found before the season in this packet, on www.nbgc.org/fall, and in the parent guide for a sport.
 - Game schedules will be available in the inbox of email addresses provided at registration and on www.nbgc.org/fall following the conclusion of preseason practices and 3-7 days before the first scheduled game for that league.
